SciFi Project

As an ending to the SciFi genre unit, you will complete <u>one</u> of the following projects individually or with a group of your choice, depending on which project you choose.

- A. With no more than 2 other people (3 people per group maximum): create a science fictional device/object/machine/etc. as a real object which has a purpose in a story. Then, after the creation of this object (which will be presented to the class), write a script outline of 8-10 scenes (each about 3 sentences in length) of your SciFi film including the major role this device/object plays.
- B. **Individually OR with one partner**: Create a comic book storyboard of an <u>original</u> SciFi movie idea with 8-10 scenes/drawings representing the entire film from beginning to end. Drawings should each have a caption of 1-2 sentences to describe the scene as well as any dialogue/writing in the picture itself.
- C. Individually OR with one partner: As in previous assignments, write a SciFi script outline melting it with another genre from previous study. Example, a SciFi Comedy or a SciFi Thriller. Your scene outline (6-8 scenes of about 3 sentences each) should clearly depict the outstanding elements of both SciFi and your other chosen genre throughout your writing, with one short scene (1-2 pages) which depicts elements of both genres. Additionally, you could add a drawing of part of your script for extra credit as well.
